We will purchase new promo materials, provide outside programming and update our website.


The library will expand programming based on community interests.

LIBRARY UPDATES



New Sign & Front Siding

In fall of 2024, the library got a facelift! The new sign was installed by First Class Signs, and vertical steel siding replaced the rotting plywood facade. The new materials will require zero maintenance and will last for years to come!

Special thanks to POET Biorefining out of Jewell for helping to fund the project with a community grant.

Fresh Paint & New LVP Flooring

In May of 2025, the library staff tackled the huge project of moving everything in the library. First, staff moved all the books off the shelves to paint a fresh coat on the ceilings and the walls. Then, everything had to move out of the library, including the old carpet squares, to prepare for the flooring replacement. Gilbert Flooring out of Webster City installed the new Luxury Vinyl Plank flooring in the library before moving onto the museum. The whole process took a little less than 3 weeks.

Year in Review

We are dedicated to our community and are constantly adding new programs and materials to meet the needs of its people. This year was no exception. The Ellsworth Public Library added 473 new materials worth \$7,209.52 through its purchasing budget and community donations.

This year, we also added an after school program for elementary kids and the Balance Agility Strength and Endurance (BASE) Exercise Group for adults 55 and older to our weekly program offerings. At the after school program, kids received snacks and an hour of screen-free enrichment activities. The BASE program has brought many seniors together for closer community and healthier living. Through these activities, we are improving the quality of life in our community.

Patrons Saved \$45,608.15
